

## **ST2 Teaching Guidance 2021-2022**

**UPDATED 25.08.21**

- The teaching programme will run from September until July. It will consist of 10 curriculum topics which will be repeated twice in a one month period (approximately).
- It is the trainee's responsibility to check the timetable and confirm availability with their hospital department or GP practice before booking a place with the GP Office. Please liaise with your ST colleagues and rota organisers to share opportunities equally.
- Attendance numbers at each session will be capped with priority given to trainees in a hospital placement.
- If there is availability trainees in a GP placement may attend twice in one month if agreed with the practice.
- All trainees to sign up in advance to show a presentation (based on listed curriculum topics). Further information about what is expected from presentations can be found below.
- There is the expectation that trainees are to reach a minimum of 70% attendance based on 10 teaching sessions overall each academic year. Pro-rata for LTFT trainees.
- Additional Topic Teaching sessions will be held approximately once a month. Attendance for all ST1s and ST2s is strongly encouraged and mandatory for all ST3s to attend. Some Topic Teaching is organised on our behalf by BGPert, our external education provider.

- Regular teaching reminders will be sent out (please plan ahead).
- If you find you cannot attend please let the GP Office know as a courtesy.
- If you do not complete the Survey Monkey online feedback your attendance will not be recorded.
- Regular checks of teaching attendance will be made, especially around 6 month review and ARCP periods.
- If it is on the teaching timetable an Intrepid study leave application does not need to be submitted.
- Virtual teaching sessions will not be recorded unless otherwise advised.

### **Planned format of ST2 Teaching**

9.00am	Art/Humanities Introduction
9.30am	Clinical topic presentation by a ST2 in a GP practice
10.30am	Break
11.00am	Small group work – Hospital trainees/GP trainees
12.30pm	End of session

During ST2 you will each be asked to contribute to the Wednesday teaching sessions, taking turns to do a topic-based presentation. We would like these to last no more than an hour, ideally pick only one topic from the GP curriculum for that clinical area. You might want to choose a clinical guideline, or share case studies, everyone also seems to 'enjoy' practice exam questions (!)...try to make it interactive and make your audience work too!

Please check in with the one of the TPDs facilitating the session or your Lead TPD in preparation, so we can help you decide what to talk about, and liaise with your ST2 colleague doing the other session from this clinical area, as some trainees may attend both and it would be good not to duplicate.
